Established in 2015 by Regent Charles Berolzheimer, the Pacific Learning Innovation Fund provides students and faculty with resources to pursue programs and opportunities that foster experiential learning, interdisciplinary innovation, venture development and champion the liberal arts in alignment with the university's academic plan.

The fund has been used to purchase the latest digital technology, fund conference and internship opportunities, trade show competitions and more. Most recently, the fund was used to develop a multidisciplinary minor in Design and Entrepreneurship housed within the School of Engineering and Computer Science and the Eberhardt School of Business. The library also used the fund to purchase 3D printers that were instrumental in alleviating the PPE shortage caused by the pandemic.

When COVID-19 hit, the library helped print 10,000 face shields and 4,000 ear guards in partnership with the Print to Protect Coalition. This PPE was then donated to nursing homes, health care workers, first responders and more.
